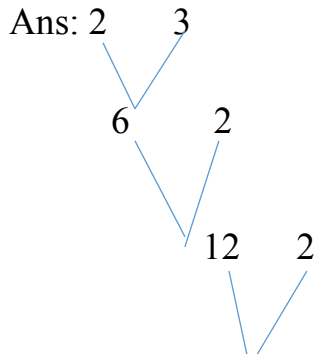
BE MY MULTIPLE,I'LL BE YOUR FACTOR

IMPORTANT POINTS

1. **MULTIPLE:** Multiple means to write the table of that number.
Example:Multiples of 3 are 3,6,9,12,15,18,21.....
2. **FACTOR:** A number which can divide given number exactly is called the factor of that given number.
Example: Factors of 12 are 1,2,3,4,6,12.
3. Write any multiples of 5:
Ans: 5,10,15,20,25,30,35,40,45,50
4. Write the smallest common multiples of 3 and 5:
Ans:
Multiple of 3 is 3,6,9,12,15,18,21,24....
Multiple of 5 is 5,10,15,20,25,30,35.....
The smallest common multiple of both 3 and 5 is 15.
5. Write the factors of 10:
Ans:1,2,5,10.
We can find it from chart also

6. Write the common factors of 25 and 35:
Ans: Factors of 25 are 1,5,25
Factors of 35 are 1,5,7,35
The common factors of both 25 and 35 is 1,5
7. Draw the Factor tree for the 18:

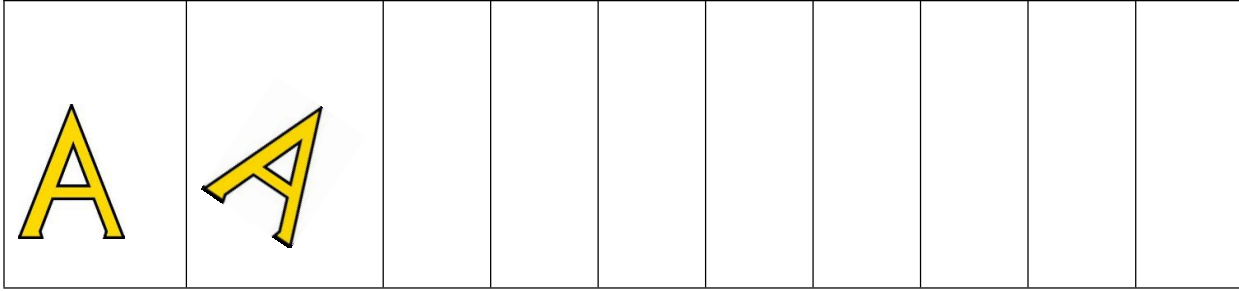


CAN YOU SEE THE PATTERN
