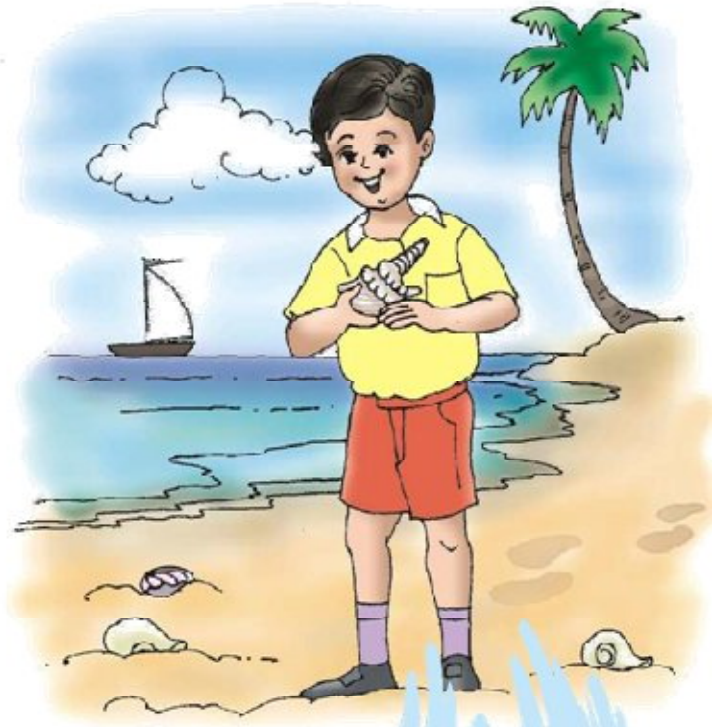


## Sea Song

Three main tenses are

1. Present tense
2. Past tense
3. Future tense

**Present Tense:**

Present tense denotes an action taking place in the present time.

**Past Tense:**

The past tense denotes an action that happened in the past time.

**Future Tense:**

The future tense denotes an action that will happen in future.
